





Registration Information

- 1. Go to http://v2.4honline.com
- 2. If you have an account in 4-H online, enter the login information for your existing account and skip to Member Enrollment. If you've never had an account in 4-H Online, click "Don't have an account".
- 3. Once the 4-H Online login process is complete, proceed to your family profile and member list. Click "View" by the member you intend to register for an Event that registration has been started by your county office.
- 4. Select the Events Tab once you are in their profile and find the event that has been started for them that would be in "Incomplete" and select it.
- 5. Complete any required questions/sessions.
- 6. Complete the Health Form (this is required for all summer events).
- 7. Complete Consents.
- 8. The only allowed of payment for these summer events is check so indicate you will pay by check and submit payment to your county extension office.
- Select Next once payment has been selected. And then Finish.
- 10.A list of event registrations that have been submitted will appear and your county will accept your registration.

Payment should be either cash or check, made payable to Winnebago County Extension. Credit card payments will not be accepted. Fees for service will be used to offset direct expenses and to support the 4-H Youth Development and Winnebago Extension Program.
